3. Closer to Christ

The first of the launch meetings lead by the fund raiser, Matt prior to the PPC.

PP and LB summarised the meeting. There was a spirited discussion in which JP voiced his reservations about the way the request for funds had been done. The discussion brought out the following points:

- that the monies were additional to current giving
- that the diocese was hoping to persuade people to make a 'pledge' so the diocese can forecast income.
- The pledges are not legally binding and can be revoked at any time if circumstances change.
- that the main purpose was to support seminarians, retired priests and those in post
- that this money is needed to safeguard training of the next generation of priests and to meet our obligations to support retired priests
- that giving was not mandatory
- that the hiring by the diocese of a professional full time fund raising organisation rather than relying of volunteers was a necessary to practically raise the funds in the time required.

While mathematically our parish target of £40,000 was not much if spread over all parishioners Matt said that in practice for various reasons it normally happens that a minority of better off parishioners end up contributing the majority of the funds. He handed out folders containing information brochures and giving forms which provide for several methods of giving.

The plan is to deliver more intimate launch sessions like this one in the new year; and presentations to the whole parish, with a view to concluding efforts by the end of February 23.

4. Evangelisation

JP presented some ideas on evangelisation activities for 2023. Some suggestions might be:

- A living crib for Christmas 2023
- Talks in the church hall on topics such as
- GK Chesterton, author of works with Christian themes
- Talks on art works with a Christian message
- Talk on Mary, Mother of God...a talk by Rev Talisker,
- A talk by Rev Pickering
- Processions around Faringdon on Christian Feast Days
- A talk on the Catholic symbols you see in a Catholic church
