The role of the Design Group



- Support the Pastoral Area Clergy in responding to YWBMW
 - Designing a cohesive approach to be adopted by parishes
 - Orchestrate parishioners in their activity
 - Provide tools to support parishes (models, methods, frameworks etc)
 - Provide an assurance framework for clergy to demonstrate accountability
 - Develop a communications strategy & plan

The importance of communication



- Clear and consistent communication is imperative
 - Engenders ownership and participation
 - Develops trust
- Considerations
 - Different people consume communication in different ways
 - "Transmit" does not assure "receive"
- Initially, prime communicators are the clergy
- Naming the programme will give it an identity & distinguish PA level from parish level

Programme name




A programme of this importance, spanning the period of time envisaged and needing to engage with so many people, needs to have an identity, something people can identify with and get behind.



 - Consider costs


